CADA'S JOURNEY FROM JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2024



It was another remarkable moment for some disadvantaged youths and participants who have been receiving training at CADA's Art School located at Nkwen, Bamenda, Northwest region of Cameroon. Following a three month mentorship program which is a component of our flagship program, some successful participants among them school drop outs, internally displaced youths, drug addicts were able to set up small social business ventures from seed funding offered by Collective Arts Development Association(CADA).

During this time, the organization through a humanitarian response call, registered seven participants among them orphans, internally displaced and homeless youths between the ages 07-24 years. They have been receiving training in ICT, drawing, painting and craft production. It is worth noted that these children and youths became orphans, internally displaced and homeless as a result of the Anglophone crisis which led to the burning down of villages, houses, kidnappings and indiscriminate shooting and killing of civilians.

Once again, we want to take this opportunity to express our deep appreciation to our collaborators and welwishers for their immerse material, moral and financial assistance. Without which we would never have come this far.
